This statement is made in accordance with Section 54 of the Modern Slavery Act 2015 (the “Act”) for the year ended 31 December 2019.

Commitment and approach

At Clever Recycling LTD, we have utilised a range of information sources to help us identify potential modern slavery risk areas, and as a result have focused our efforts to mitigate these risks in our supply chain and the employment of migrant workers.
